Pedalling for a cleaner, greener city

For better eco and fuel conservation, a group of cyclists from Thane and Mulund takes to the road

In an effort to bring down the impact of global warming in the twin cities of Thane and Mulund, a group of cyclists from both the places have switched to cycling. Known as Lake City Peddlers, what was initiated in March, 2008, is today a continued effort with 20 cyclists cycling for about 25 kms to promote environment conservation.

Surprisingly, cyclists from this group were never passionate about cycling. "This idea of bringing together cyclists from the city came to me from my customers to whom I sold cycles.

Though it is a small contribution to protect the environment, but it is worth the effort," says Jose George, 42, a Thane resident and a marine engineer with the merchant navy. He had opened a cycle store in Thane two years ago after which he took a break from his work. "Being in Thane is an advantage for cyclists from this city. Of course, we have better roads and trails spots which make cycling interesting," he said.

Ghodbunder Road and Yeoor jungle are two areas where these cyclists like to go quite often. "The credit goes to T Chandrasekhar, former Thane municipal commissioner, because of whom we have a wide road along with service road."

"Cycling here is fun. According to me, more people should take up cycling for a better Thane and I guess this would happen soon," said Renny Varghese, 24, another cyclist from Thane and an architect by profession.

"It hurts to see the traffic chaos and all sorts



of pollution engulfing us. I am trying to contribute, in my capacity, to create a better tomorrow, at least a better Mulund," says Yagnesh Katira, 19, from Mulund. He has been promoting the use of cycle for covering short distances. Yagnesh, who was born and bought up in Mulund, started an initiative called Cycle-e-Thon since 2006 with a three-pronged objective. He says, "The objective of the initiative is to promote using cycle for short-distance travel that will reduce parking and pollution woes. Also, this would result in fuel conservation.

Yagnesh is a SYBCom student of VG Vaze College in Mulund. He has been supportive of a separate cycling track in Mulund for which he held a signature campaign last year. Under the banner of Cycle-e-Thon initiative, he has held several cycling sessions for school students and youngsters. Talking about Mulund, Yagnesh said, "I wish Mulund gets the first cycling track.'

Omkar is the founder of 'Omkar frame library of inspirational and motivational thoughts', a unique concept library in Thane that's been operational since 2005.

'Omkar — a deaf and mute project' which started as an experimental venture has turned Omkar into an entrepreneur selling influential quotes, touching thoughts, motivational statements to over more than 700 clients across Mumbai, Thane and Pune. For this lad with a never-




